Baron recKids Parents,

After communication with Manheim Central School District staff, it has been determined that Baron recKids will be eligible to use the facilities in the district for our Before and After School Programs, despite the COVID pandemic. All sites will remain the same as in the past, however there will be some new guidelines and safety precautions. Please know all changes/updates will be communicated to MCSD through the CSD director.

Please see the requirements below:

COVID Screening:

*All parents will be required to temp check at home each morning before dropping their child off with recKids/or school.

*All parents will sign a waiver stating that their child is fever free (under 100.0) and does not show any signs of a fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, etc. at the beginning of the school year. This will be a one-time waiver, unlike the daily waiver from the summer.

*All parents will answer the DHS required COVID questions as part of the COVID waiver.

*All parents will be responsible to notify the staff, if any of the waiver questions/answers have changed.

*All staff will be required to temp check at home each time before they enter the site daily.

*All staff will answer the COVID questions before entering the site daily.

Confirmed COVID Case:

*If there is a known **positive** COVID case, DOH requires the site to close for 48 hours for deep cleaning.

*Staff and students may return after the 48 hours if they are symptom free.

*If a staff or student is showing any symptoms, they must quarantine for 14 days or until COVID test results are returned.

*recKids will also follow any guidelines MCSD or PA DHS requires on a case by case basis.

Cleaning procedures:

*Each site will be equipped with cleaning supplies to regularly and routinely clean and sanitize the areas that they will be using. All staff will be trained in cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting.

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Max number of students per site:

*There will be 36 students maximum enrolled at each site.

*There will be 3 or 4 staff maximum at each site. (This would not include TSS or other specialized staff not employed by the rec)

*Each site will break the students into pods of 12 or less.

*Each staff member will be responsible for the same “pod” each day.

Social Distancing:

*recKids will continue to practice recommended safety protocols that are advised from DHS including proper social distancing guidelines.

*Staff will limit the number of students in large group areas at one time. (gym/playground)

Masks:

*DHS requires that all staff and students wear a mask at all times when feasible.

*Students will be asked to bring an extra mask in their backpack each day. (lost, broken, dirty masks will be replaced with extra)

Shared Materials:

*Each family will be asked to leave personal belongings and toys at home.

*Staff will monitor the use of all materials and take all necessary cleaning and sanitizing precautions each day.

*All soft or non-washable items will be removed from each site. (cloth chairs, pillows, etc.)

Parent pickup/drop-off:

*All students will be dropped off and picked up at the door of each site.

*Parents will not be entering the site for any reason.

*All parents will be required to have a face covering to walk their child to the door for drop off and pickup.
